

Lesson 22: An Angel Frees Peter from Jail

Worship Theme: God sends angels to help us.

Pray

Song: Select songs from the list above.

Icebreaker: Pop the Balloon

Materials needed: Balloon, strings (to tie the children’s ankles)



1. Pair up the children.
2. Teacher ties the children's legs in pairs and tie the balloon to the children's other ankle.
3. The children use their feet to pop the balloon of another group, but they also need to protect their own balloon from the other group.
4. After the game, explain that what we cannot do alone, we can do it with help from others. In the same way, Jesus sends angels to help us.

Introduction: What Does the Bible Say About Angels?

Material Needed: Print the bible verses and cut them out (see below to print)

Have you ever seen a prisoner? Have you ever seen an angel? What is an angel?

1. Divide the children into groups of 3-4 and give them 1 or 2 bible verses
2. Ask them to read the verses and explain what the bible says about angels
3. After reading the verses, children should be able to see that angels help and protect humans or send us God’s messages. Because of his great love, he sends his angels to help us. Let’s learn about a story when God

sent an angel to help Peter!

Bible Story:

Long ago, King Herod arrested one of Jesus’ disciples and put him in jail. The disciple’s name was Peter. When Peter’s friends learned that Peter was in jail, they were very upset. Peter’s friends prayed for Peter and asked God to keep him safe. God heard their prayers. He sent someone special to set Peter free from jail. The special person God sent to help Peter was an angel! We don’t know the angel’s name, but he appeared while Peter was sleeping. There was a bright light in the jail. The angel woke Peter up, and Peter’s chains fell off! He told Peter to get up and get dressed. Then the angel led Peter out of jail, past the guards, and safely to his friend’s house! No one seemed to see Peter getting out of jail! Even Peter thought he was dreaming until he got out to the streets. This was a miracle! God answered the prayers that Peter’s friends prayed for him by sending an angel to help Peter! God sends angels for us even today! He knows when we need help, and the angels are there to do whatever he says. Most of the time, we don’t even know when they help us. We can’t see angels unless God wants us to see them. That’s because too many people would

worship angels instead of God. Angels only go where God sends them, and they do only what he tells them to do. And God commands angels to help us! God loves us so much!

Think of something in your life where you need God's help. Maybe you need help to do better in school, obey your parents, or follow God more faithfully. Maybe you have to do something difficult this week or someone you love needs God's help. Some of you may need the help of angels this week. If you do, God will send them, because God sends angels. Whether he sends angels or not, God will take care of all your needs. God is good!

Questions to discuss:

1. Who got arrested by King Herod? (Peter)
2. What did Peter's friend do when they heard that Peter was in jail? (They prayed)
3. Who came to help Peter get out of jail? (An angel)
4. Who sent the angel? (God)
5. Do you think God would send an angel to help you? (Yes/No) What help do you need from God right now? (Let the children answer)

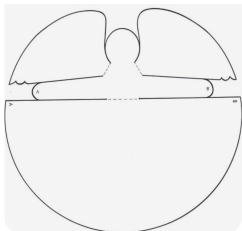
Game: True? or False?

1. Everyone needs to stand in the middle of the room.
2. If what the teacher says about angels is true, walk to the back of the room.
3. If what the teacher says is false, walk to the front of the room.
4. If you don't know, stay in the center of the room.
 - Angels are God's servants. (True)

 - Angels are as powerful as God. (False - they only do what God commands them to do)
 - Angels want to be worshipped. (False - angels want to worship God)

5. Remember, God sends angels because he loves us. We may never see an angel in our lives, but we can be sure that they are around us, walk with us, and watch over us. Even though they do amazing things, we never worship angels. They are only created beings, like we are. God is the one to worship and praise. He is the Creator of us all.

Memory Verse: "For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways." (Psalm 91:11)

1. Decorate the angel and cut out solid lines.
2. Fold the dotted lines and glue A and B together (see example of the completed angel)
3. Remind the children that God sends angels to help them!
